





#### Particularities

The male dairy calves are bought from domestic dairy farms. The weaners coming as well from domestic farms. The calves have three feeding periods (lactating diet, starter concentrates period and concentrates). The farm operates with relatively old stables designed for intensive finishing (feedlot). These kind of farms can rapidly change the type of animal to be fattened during the year due to the market conditions like availability of calves, price opportunity for purchases and regional beef demand.
