- Lantmännen is one of Sweden's largest companies within food and agriculture
- Turnover: 28,2 billion SEK (=3 billion EURO)
- 11,000 employees in 16 countries
- Owned by 50,000 Swedish farmers





Lantmännen's mission is:

- contribute to the profitability of its owners' farms (utility role)
- to maximise the return on the capital that the owners have invested in the association (ownership role)

Lantmännen Group

- The core business is feed, seed, fertiliser, crop protection and grain business
- The rest of the business is divided into 8 units:
 - -- SW (Svalöf Weibull) (plant breeding, seed production)
 - Machines (Valtra, Fendt, Claas, Väderstad, Överum)
 - Granngården (store chain, 119 outlets, mail-order company)
 - Energy (ethanol, RME, wood chips, wood pellets, oats and straw for burning)
 - Cerealia Mills (flour&mixes for industrial customers)
 - Cerealia Foods & Bread (flour, mixes, fresh bread, breakfast cereals, pasta)
 - Cerealia Bakeries (fast food & bake off-products)
 - Invest (laboratory (AnalyCen), farm buildings, chicken, horse and dog feed, starch, Cedomon, ThermoSeed)






Växtråd

 with totally 100 000 ha






Temperature is limiting Swedish crop production







Crops 2005, totally 2,68 milj. ha






The average farm of VäxtRåds clients


- Cultivates 225 ha
- Only cereals, no livestock,
- Grows 40% winter wheat, 30% barley/oats, 20% rape, 10 % spring wheat
- 25 % of the income originate from other profession such as snow ploughing

Farming trends in Sweden

- More set-aside and extensive grassland
- Growing interest of producing bioenergy
- Bigger farms, 500-1000 ha (tenancy, co-operation, buy) or part time farming
- Increasing interest of reduced tillage
- More machinery contractors and co-operation
- Increasing age of the farmers, average age 55
- 7 % organic farming today. The government goal is 15 % 2015
